### We Feed People

- 2 Crop Drops and gleaning produced 116,000 lbs of produce, fruit and bread 261,000 servings
- 15,533 lbs. of fresh vegetables and 21,000 stems of flowers grown in the Concord Community Garden were shared at 21 local pantries
- 1,500+ people were fed breakfast at the Volunteer Ministry Center
- 17,000+ food and hygiene items were donated to Shepherd of Hope Food pantry and \$8,060 was spent to purchase hygiene items - \$34,00 donated
- 2,800 soup mixes were packaged providing over 22,000 servings of soup
- 50 food buckets were sent to Zimbabwe providing food for 400 people

#### We Serve People

- The Thrift Store continues to provide quality items at very affordable prices and has helped families in need with items at no cost. Missions gave 300 \$25 gift vouchers to accompany the Christmas gifts for TREKK and Giving Tree.
- Concord's Project Linus Team made and donated 505 items in 2024; 450 blankets and 55 pillowcases/other extras.
- **3,400** diapers and other items were supplied to Helping Mamas with over \$1,875 donations from our collections.
- 11 mentors worked with children through the Kids Hope program at Cedar Bluff Elementary.
- Responded immediately to victims of Hurricane Helene with donations of items, money, volunteers to work at distribution centers and sending teams to Greeneville, TN and Mountain City, TN to help with flood recovery.
- Loaned Medical equipment to those in our church and community.
