## We Feed People

- 2 Crop Drops and gleaning produced 125,685 lbs of produce, fruit and bread – 326,955 servings
- 17,500 lbs of fresh vegetables, enough to feed over 54,000 people, were grown in the Concord Community Garden and shared at 21 local pantries and feeding locations
- 1,500+ breakfasts were served at the Volunteer Ministry Center
- Almost 12,000 food and hygiene items were donated to the Shepherd of Hope Food pantry and \$4,672 was spent to purchase hygiene items.
- Donations of \$56,237 were made to the Pantry Fund
- 1,618 packages of soup mix were packaged providing 12,944 servings of soup
- 50 food buckets were sent to Zimbabwe providing food for 400 people

## We Serve People

- We helped 2 families in Greene County and 10 families in Mountain City rebuild after Hurricane Helene and were able to celebrate Thanksgiving back in their homes due to the donations and volunteers from Concord United.
- The Thrift Store continues to provide quality items at very affordable prices and has helped families in need with items at no cost to them. Missions gave 190 \$25 gift vouchers to area agencies to hand out at Christmas
- Concord's Project Linus Team made and donated 504 items 2025. This represents 10% of the total made in the East TN Chapter.
- 9 mentors worked with children through the Kids Hope program at Cedar Bluff Elementary
- Continued to loan medical equipment to those in our church and community
